Uniform Policy



Our school community strongly support the wearing of school uniforms. Children should be encouraged to wear the uniform at all times. The school uniform should be worn on school excursions.

Parents and guardians should **ENSURE THAT ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING ARE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THEIR CHILD'S NAME**. Each item of clothing that is found with a child's name on it can be returned to the child, but unmarked items will be held for a time and then transferred to the school's Uniform Pool, or given to local charitable organisations. (See the section on **LOST PROPERTY** for further details.)

The UNIFORM SHOP is located in the School hall and is currently open on Mondays from 2.30pm until 3.00pm and Fridays from 8.45am until 9.15am. These times may change in 2019. The uniform shop is operated by parent volunteers. If you need assistance with paying for the uniform, please speak to the office staff.

SUMMER

BOYS

Grey shorts with school socks.

Socks are grey with bands of light and dark blue at the top.

Pale blue polo shirt

Black lace up school shoes

NO SANDALS OR SLIP ON SHOES ALLOWED

Hats in school colours are available at school.

GIRLS

Blue checked summer dress.

(Limited) material is available at school.

Dresses can be made to order through the school.

Light blue or royal blue hair ribbon (if worn).

Grey skorts

Black school shoes with white socks

NO SANDALS OR SLIP ON SHOES ALLOWED

Hats in school colours are available at school.

WINTER

BOYS

Grey long trousers with short, grey school socks
Royal blue sloppy joe with school crest or polar fleece jumper
Pale blue long sleeved polo shirt
Light blue skivvy
Black school shoes
Blue school beanie, Terms 2 and 3.

GIRLS

Regulation navy/tartan slacks or tartan tunic.
Royal blue sloppy joe with school crest
Pale blue long sleeved polo shirt
Light blue skivvy
Black school shoes
Short white ankle socks or navy stockings/tight.
Blue school beanie, Terms 2 and 3

PLEASE NOTE

Parkas and coats should be navy or royal blue. However, on wet days children are advised to wear raincoats and/or rain hats that are in good safety colours like yellow.

SUMMER SPORTS UNIFORM

BOYS

Royal blue all-purpose shorts
School polo shirt
White ankle socks
Sports shoes or sandshoes

GIRLS

Royal blue basketball shorts and blue skirt or blue shorts
School polo shirt
White ankle socks
Sports shoes or sandshoes

WINTER SPORTS UNIFORM

BOYS/GIRLS

Royal blue track suit, available at school.

Uniform Pool

The School Uniform Pool provides a means of getting full value from school uniforms. Often they are outgrown but are still quite serviceable. If this is the case, parents are invited to donate them to the Uniform Pool so that they are then available for other parents to purchase at a nominal price. Some parents may prefer to sell their surplus uniforms through the Uniform Pool. If you wish to do this, simply decide upon an appropriate price, attach that to the uniform, and send or bring both to the office where we will endeavour to sell them for you.

Lost Property

Clothing lost at school is placed in Lost Property Boxes. One is located near the Kindergarten classrooms and another near the hall. Parents are also encouraged to come along and look in the boxes whenever their children loses clothing at school. Remember, if clothing is clearly labelled with the owner's name, it can be returned quickly and easily.

At times, clothing that has been in the Lost Property Boxes for some time is displayed at assembly. On other occasions, parents are advised through the School Newsletter that clothing can be inspected in the office area. Items that are still unclaimed after this process are placed in the Uniform Pool, given to families or given to a local charity.
