## Loud Shirt Day



## National Partnerships Surveys


Over the past four years Goulburn North Public School has been fortunate to participate in the Commonwealth Government National Partnerships.

Congratulations to the above students who received their UNSW Participation Certificates for Mathematics. Well done.


## Transfer of Student Information
