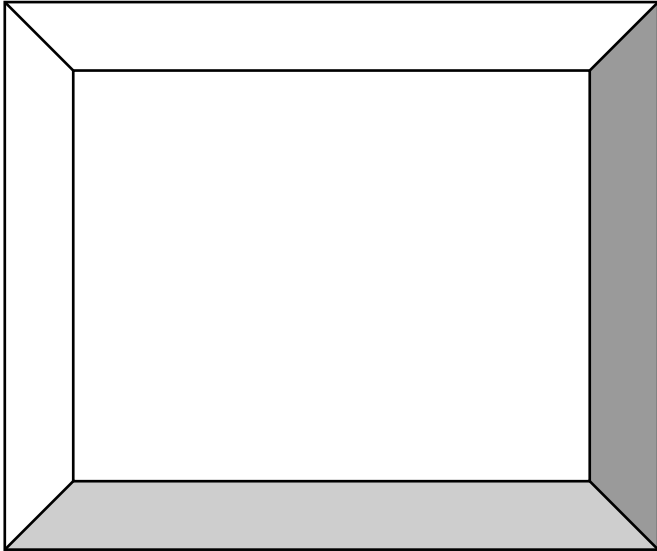
Sleeping Beauty Performance

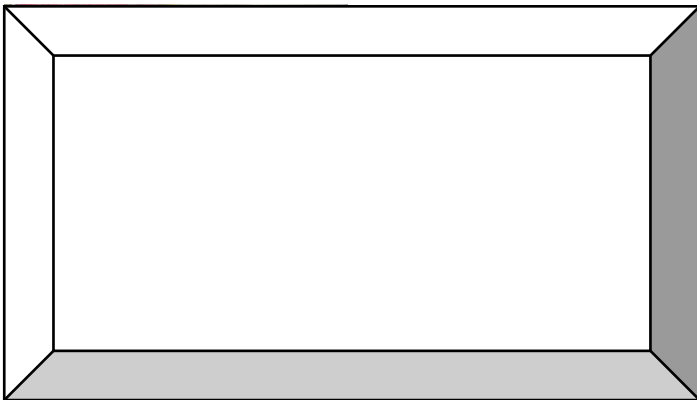

1B Christmas Sewing

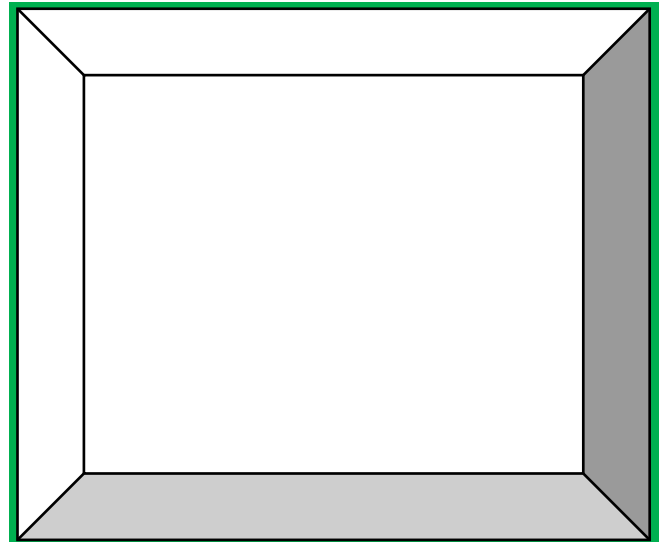

- Musica Viva refunds have also been processed and are being sent home with students.

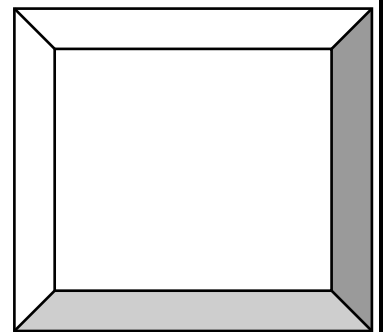

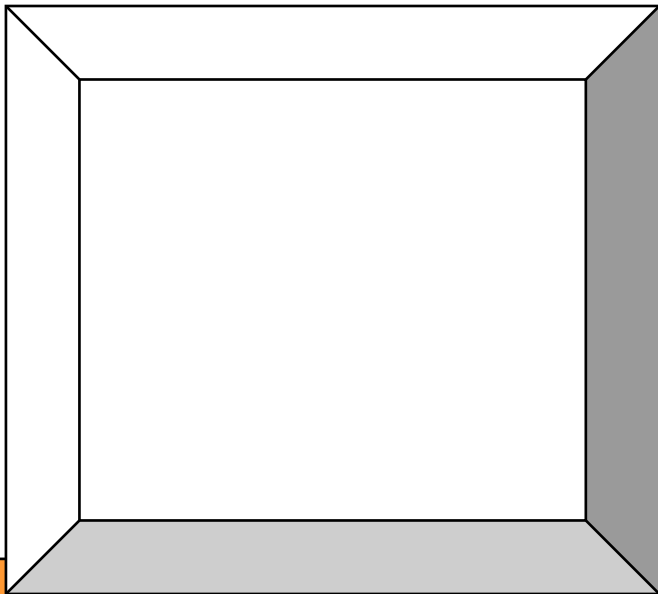
