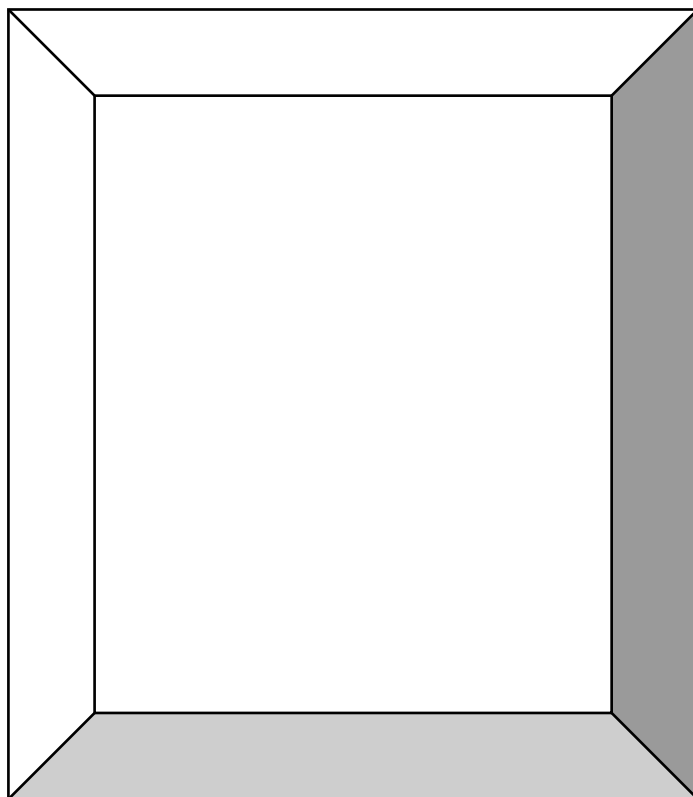

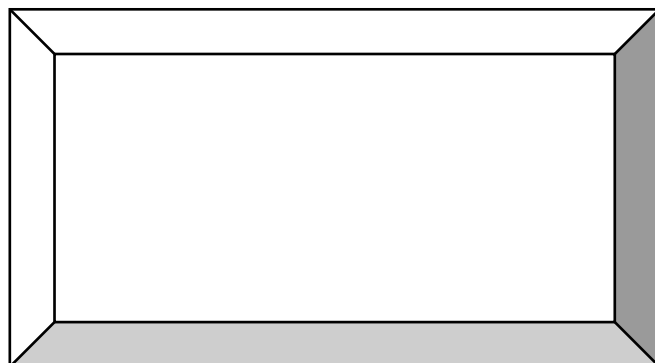

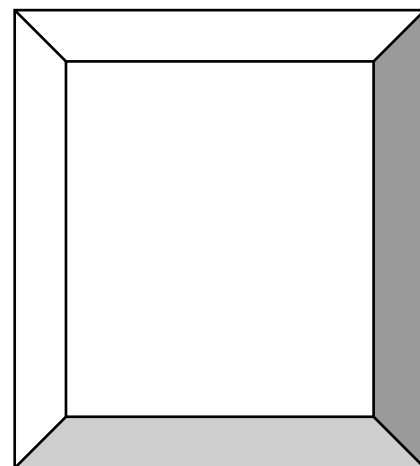

# Mayoral Civic Reception

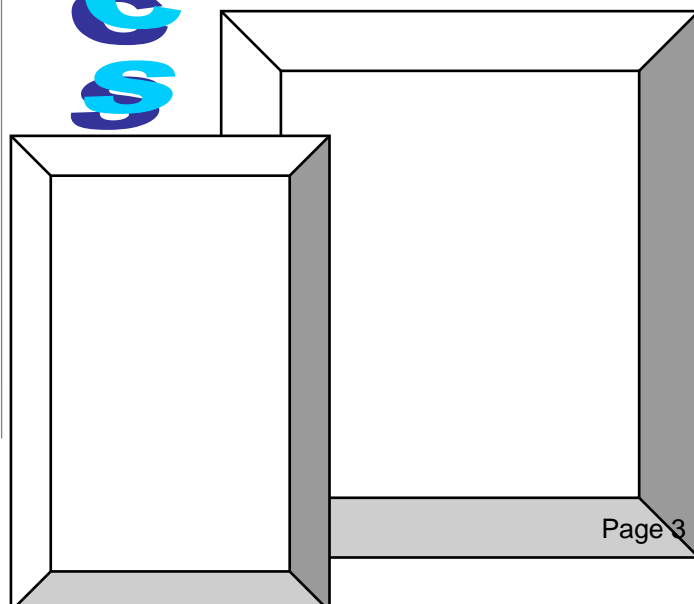
